Day 3 TEL AVIV – JAFFA – CAESAREA – ACRE – NAZARETH – CANA - TIBERIAS

After breakfast, journey to the ancient port city of Jaffa for a leisurely stroll through the winding alleys of the historic area. Celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Church. Travel to the walled city and Roman ruins of Caesarea. Next, stop in Acre, a UNESCO World Heritage site. On to Cana, the site of Our Lord's first Miracle, at the wedding feast where you can renew your marriage vows. Enjoy a Falafel lunch in Cana. Drive to Nazareth. Visit St Joseph Carpentry workshop. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias. (B,L,D)

Day 4 TIBERIAS – SEA OF GALILEE – TABGHA – CAPERNAUM - TIBERIAS

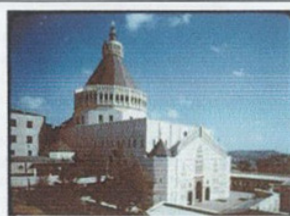
This morning, take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Travel to nearby Tabgha and visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes. Stop at the Mount of Beatitudes. Continue to the Church of the Primacy of St. Peter where Our Lord appeared to the apostles after His resurrection. In Capernaum, visit the church built over the ruins of St. Peter's house. After lunch featuring "St. Peter's Fish", cross the Jordan River to visit the Golan Heights. Finally, visit Yardenit, the Jordan River baptismal site. (B,L,D)

Day 5 TIBERIAS – MOUNT TABOR – BETHLEHEM - JERUSALEM

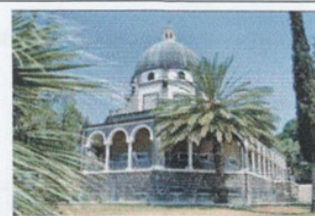
Travel to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. Proceed to Bethlehem and enjoy a stop at Shepherds' Field, where the angels appeared on the first Christmas night. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Nativity, built on the birth site of Our Lord. Later, arrive in Jerusalem. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 6 JERUSALEM, the OLD CITY

Your visit to Jerusalem begins with a visit to the Mount of Olives and the site where Our Lord wept over the city, now known as Dominus Flevit. Afterwards, visit the Church of All Nations built over the rock on which Our Lord prayed the night before He was crucified. Continue to the Church of the Paternoster built on the traditional site where Jesus taught His disciples the Lord's Prayer; its name refers to the "Our Father" prayer. Nearby is the tomb of the Virgin Mary and the Garden of Gethsemane, the site of Christ's betrayal by Judas. Travel to Gallicantu where St. Peter once denied Our Lord. This afternoon, travel to Ein Karem to visit the Church of St. John the Baptist, built over the Grotto of his birthplace, and celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 7 JERUSALEM

After breakfast, you are free to explore the city on your own. Perhaps you'll choose to take an optional excursion (Approx. Cost: \$100pp min 10) to the Dead Sea to discover where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, visit Masada and perhaps even float on the Salty waters of the Dead Sea. Later today, gather with your fellow travelers to celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. (B,D)

Day 8 JERUSALEM – WESTERN WALL

Your day begins with a visit to the Western Wall of the Temple. Then, follow the Via Dolorosa, the Way of the Cross, walked by Our Lord on the way to His crucifixion. Afterwards, pass through St. Stephen's Gate where St. Stephen, the first Christian martyr, was stoned to death. Continue to the Church of St. Anne marking the place where the parents of the Blessed Mother lived. Visit the nearby Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the paralytic, and see the Ecce Homo Arch, the site where Pontius Pilate presented Our Lord to the crowds. Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the site of His crucifixion, burial and resurrection. Next, visit the Church of the Dormition, commemorating Our Lady's Assumption, and the nearby Hall of the Last Supper. Dinner on your own. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B)

Day 9 JERUSALEM

After breakfast, check out of hotel. Visit Israeli Museum by tram. Attend our last Mass, followed by a Farewell Dinner. Depart after dinner for the airport. (B,D)

Day 10 USA Arrive back home.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

(Deposits, Second payments, and Final payments)

*A deposit of \$300 is required no later than 95 days prior to departure to secure a reservation. There is no guarantee we can obtain airline seats for late bookings. FULL payment is due no later than 65 days prior to departure. Late payments can be assessed a \$100 late fee. Reservations may be cancelled and we reserve the right to levy full cancellation charges as set forth in these conditions if full payment is not received 65 days prior to the departure date of the tour. In the event of billing error, we reserve the right to reinvoice with correct pricing. Final documents and tickets will be issued after final payment has been processed, and normally will be sent 1 - 2 weeks prior to departure.

General:

*Deposit is necessary to secure a reservation.

*For late bookings (within 60 days of departure), full payment is due immediately by bank check or money order. No reservations will be accepted 45 days or less before departure.

*Late bookings (within 60 days of departure) are subject to a \$100.00 late fee plus any increase in quoted airfare.

*All payments, except late bookings, can be made by personal check, bank check or money order. Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express will be accepted for all payments except late bookings. Credit cards will not be accepted for reservations made by travel agents.

*No personal checks or credit cards will be accepted with payments 45 days or less before departure date. Only money orders or cashier's checks will be accepted.

CANCELLATION INFORMATION:

All Cancellations must be in writing to us and must be signed by the person who made the original reservation. Cancellations are only effective from the day they are actually received by The Catholic Tour. US Postmark prevails. No refunds are issued for cancellations received after the departure date of the tour. Penalties will apply. If you cancel your tour, cancellation fees and penalties will be deducted from your refund. Cancellation fees do apply to deposit checks. Cancellation fees apply to each person. Prior to Departure Cancellation Fees:

ROOMS: Prices are based on double occupancy. Single rooms are available at a supplementary cost as stated on individual itineraries. A limited number of single rooms are available. On those very rare occasions when we are not able to get a roommate for you, you will be required to pay the single supplement. We will attempt to give sufficient prior notice to any room changes regarding double occupancy versus single supplement. Triple rooms may not be available in all countries.

TAXES: Tour price includes all government taxes and fees associated with the airfare. Please see individual itineraries for prices, which may vary. **Departure taxes and fuel surcharges may increase subsequent to the printing of the brochure or flyer** up until the time the group seats are purchased, typically 45 days prior to departure.

TIPPING: The price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the Tour Escort and Motor Coach Driver approximately €4 / \$5 and €2 / \$3 per person, respectively, per day to each; local step-on guides 1-2 Euros per day. **Hotel tips are not included in tours to the Middle East or on some other tours. Please refer to the individual itinerary.**

SIGHTSEEING & ITINERARIES: Sightseeing is included as per the itinerary and is under the direction of

licensed local guides where required. During holidays some sights such as museums may be closed or unavailable for visits. The Catholic Tour reserves the right to vary the sequence of sightseeing and / or to re-route the order of cities should circumstances demand it. In either case, the itinerary content will be maintained; however, the order may change. **Considerable amount of walking may be necessary while sightseeing.** Please understand that not all museums and attractions are open every day of the year. The Papal Audience takes place on Wednesdays, and the Papal Blessing is on Sundays. Both are only available in accordance with His Holiness' schedule, and may not take place when He is out of the country. There are no refunds for any unused portion of these excursions. Optional side trips and optional extensions need a minimum number of pilgrims to operate.

MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Handicapped participants who require special assistance **must** be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the handicapped participants' well being. The Catholic Tour is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior, during or after the tour.

BAGGAGE: The passenger is allowed to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 61 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:

Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups flying together for the entire itinerary. Airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. **Group air is not upgradable to First Class, Business Class, Economy Plus, etc. It is common for carriers to give partial or no mileage credit for group seats.** Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from same. **Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets.** We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination.
