## Check Your MOC Email from Anywhere

Did you know you can access your Ministry of Caring email from any internet-connected computer? Follow these instructions to use the web portal of Microsoft Outlook.

1. Open a web browser (a browser is whatever program you use to access web pages, e.g. Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, or Firefox)

2. Type in this web address and hit [Enter]:

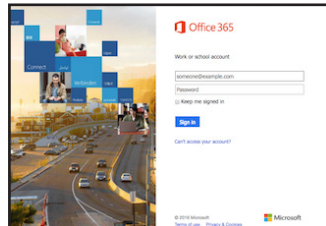

3. Enter your email address and password in the two boxes, then click the blue Sign In button.

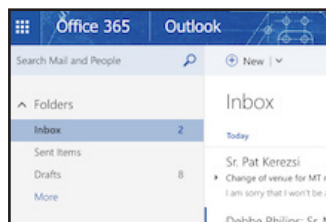
4. You should then see your email inbox.

5. You can click the white boxes at the top-left of the screen to access your calendar and contacts.

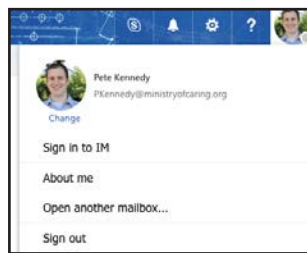
6. For security, always “Sign Out” when finished. Click the top-right corner of the window and look to the bottom of the menu.
